1 RESOLUTION

2 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS  
3 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)  
4 COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING GRANT AND PROVIDING AN  
5 APPROPRIATION TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT IN  
6 FISCAL YEAR 2023.

7 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque has developed three phases of Officer  
8 Daniel Webster Park; and

9 WHEREAS, a portion of the park remains unbuilt; and

10 WHEREAS, Officer Daniel Webster Park is designed to be inclusive of all  
11 ages and abilities; and

12 WHEREAS, grant funds in the amount of \$750,000 are available for this  
13 purpose for fiscal year 2023 from HUD Community Project Funding Grant; and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque is desirous of accepting these funds.

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF  
16 ALBUQUERQUE:

17 SECTION 1. That the HUD Community Project Funding Grant for Officer  
18 Daniel Webster Park is hereby approved, and its acceptance and filing with the  
19 appropriate official or office is in all respects approved.


20 SECTION 2. That upon approval, funds in the amount of \$752,550  
21 consisting of \$750,000 from HUD and \$2,550 for indirect costs from the  
22 Transfer to Operating Grants Fund Program in the General Fund, are hereby  
23 appropriated to the Parks & Recreation Department for Officer Daniel Webster  
24 Park in the Capital Grants Fund 305 for Fiscal Year 2023.


