2 no cruise zone.

3 (2) TRAFFIC CONTROL POINT. A location along a public way  
4 used by the city in a “no cruise zone” as an observation point to monitor  
5 traffic conditions for potential violations of this subpart.

6 (3) NO CRUISE ZONE. Those public ways so posted by the city  
7 traffic engineer in areas designated by the Mayor or the Mayor’s designee.

8 (C) Every “no cruise zone” shall be posted with sufficient signs to  
9 provide notice that cruising is prohibited in that zone.

10 (D) This subpart shall not apply to:

11 (1) Any government vehicle or ambulance operated in an official  
12 capacity; or

13 (2) Any licensed public transportation vehicle or common carrier  
14 and any business courtesy, commercial or other vehicle when operated for  
15 commercial or business purposes. +]

16 Section 3. Any person who violates this subpart shall be subject to the  
17 general penalty provisions for this article pursuant to Section 8-2-1-99(A).

18 Section 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence,  
19 clause, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or  
20 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not  
21 affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council  
22 hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section,  
23 paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any  
24 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

25 Section 5. COMPILATION. Sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance shall be  
26 incorporated in and made part of the Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque,  
27 New Mexico, 1994.

28 Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five days  
29 after publication by title and general summary.
