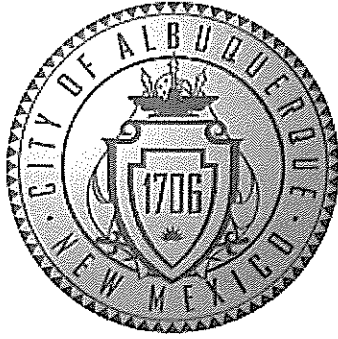

She held executive positions in global technology companies, and was an independent consultant working with nonprofits, established companies and start-ups. She is a past Director of Development for The Coe Center for the Arts in Santa Fe and Greater Albuquerque Habitat for Humanity and has served on numerous boards.

Mary Schmidt will continue to serve as an At Large representative on the committee; her second term will expire on February 1, 2029.
