Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 (G) Purchases, exchanges, sales, or transportation of: 13 (1) Animals for the BioPark/Zoo, APD, AFR and Animal Welfare Department; (2) Food, medications, medical testing, or medical supplies for animals at the BioPark/Zoo and Animal Welfare Department. SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any 23 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid. 24 SECTION 3. COMPILATION. SECTION 1 of this Ordinance amend, are incorporated in, and are to be compiled as part of the Revised Ordinances of 25 26 Albuquerque, New Mexico 1994.
