1 **RESOLUTION**

2 **COMMISSIONING COMMEMORATIVE SERVICE PLAQUES AND DEDICATING**
3 **SPACE IN CITY HALL FOR HONORING CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE CITY**
4 **COUNCILORS.**

5 **WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque has a rich history of dedicated service**
6 **by its City Councilors, who have played a crucial role in shaping the City's**
7 **development and progress; and**

8 **WHEREAS, in 1974, the City of Albuquerque adopted a form of government**
9 **that established a City Council as its legislative body; and**

10 **WHEREAS, this change in government marked a significant milestone in**
11 **Albuquerque's history, shifting the City's governance from a commission-**
12 **manager form to a council-manager form; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the establishment of the City Council provided Albuquerque**
14 **residents with a more direct voice in their City's government, allowing them to**
15 **elect their representatives and hold them accountable for their decisions; and**

16 **WHEREAS, since 1974, twenty-five elections have resulted in the selection**
17 **of twenty-five Council Sessions; and**

18 **WHEREAS, it is important to recognize and honor the commitment and**
19 **contributions of past and present City Councilors who have tirelessly served**
20 **the residents of Albuquerque; and**

21 **WHEREAS, commemorating the service of City Councilors with plaques**
22 **and dedicating space in City Hall will serve as a lasting tribute to their work**
23 **and inspire future generations of public servants; and**

24 **WHEREAS, such commemorative services and plaques will help preserve**
25 **the history of Albuquerque's governance and allow residents to connect with**
26 **the City's past leadership; and**

1 WHEREAS, dedicating space in City Hall for this purpose will provide a
2 prominent and accessible location for residents and visitors to learn about the
3 City's civic heritage.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
5 ALBUQUERQUE:

6 SECTION 1. The Director of Council Services shall secure funding for the
7 creation and installation of commemorative plaques for each Council Session
8 in honor of City Councilors who have served the City of Albuquerque.

9 SECTION 2. The General Services Department shall work in coordination
10 with the Director of Council Services to identify and allocate a suitable and
11 accessible space within City Hall for the display of these plaques.

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
