WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque has a rich history of dedicated service 5 by its City Councilors, who have played a crucial role in shaping the City's 6 7 development and progress; and 8 WHEREAS, in 1974, the City of Albuquerque adopted a form of government 9 that established a City Council as its legislative body; and 10 WHEREAS, this change in government marked a significant milestone in 11 Albuquerque's history, shifting the City's governance from a commission-12 manager form to a council-manager form; and 13 WHEREAS, the establishment of the City Council provided Albuquerque 14 residents with a more direct voice in their City's government, allowing them to 15 elect their representatives and hold them accountable for their decisions; and 16 WHEREAS, since 1974, twenty-five elections have resulted in the selection 17 of twenty-five Council Sessions; and 18 WHEREAS. it is important to recognize and honor the commitment and 19 contributions of past and present City Councilors who have tirelessly served 20 the residents of Albuquerque; and 21 WHEREAS, commemorating the service of City Councilors with plagues 22 and dedicating space in City Hall will serve as a lasting tribute to their work 23 and inspire future generations of public servants; and 24 WHEREAS, such commemorative services and plagues will help preserve 25 the history of Albuquerque's governance and allow residents to connect with

the City's past leadership; and

2	prominent and accessible location for residents and visitors to learn about the
3	City's civic heritage.

6	SECTION 1. The Director of Council Services shall secure funding for the
7	creation and installation of commemorative plaques for each Council Session
8	in honor of City Councilors who have served the City of Albuquerque.
9	SECTION 2. The General Services Department shall work in coordination
10	with the Director of Council Services to identify and allocate a suitable and
11	accessible space within City Hall for the display of these plaques.
