**6 Section 1. Amending Chapter 2, Article 12, Section 3 of the Revised
7 Ordinances of Albuquerque to extend the deadline for City Council Action on
8 the Capital Improvements Plan.**

9 **“§ 2-12-3 ADOPTING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM;**
10 **PUBLICATION.**

22 (B) The Mayor shall submit the proposed Capital Improvements
23 Program, including any recommendations of the Environmental Planning
24 Commission, to the Council by January 3 of each odd-numbered year, except
25 as provided by division (C) of this section.

17 (E) The city shall promptly publish the Capital Improvements
18 Program as approved."


19 **Section 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, paragraph, sentence,
20 clause, word or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid
21 or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall
22 not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The
23 Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each
24 section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of
25 any provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

26 Section 3. **COMPILED.** The ordinance amendment prescribed by
27 Section 1 shall amend, be incorporated in and made part of the Revised
28 ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994.

29 **Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** Section 1 of this Ordinance shall take effect
30 five days after publication by title and general summary.


