by the City pursuant to the Police Oversight Ordinance. The City shall assign

- 1 the review to a contract with hearing officer qualified pursuant to the terms 2 Administrative Hearings Ordinance to conduct a whole record review of the 3 determinations of the IRO. 4 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence, Section 4. 5 clause, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or 6 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not 7 affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council 8 hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, 9 paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any 10 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
- 11 Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five days 12 after publication by title and general summary.
