1 regular municipal elections shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first
2 Monday in November of odd-numbered years, provided that a regular
3 municipal election day may be set by election resolution on an alternate
4 date when the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November falls on a
5 recognized holiday or a recognized religious holiday or eve.

6 [(B) The Councilors representing even-numbered districts shall be elected on
7 November 2nd, 2027, except for the provisions in Article II, Section 2(B)(i).
8 Thereafter, regular general elections shall be held on the first Tuesday
9 after the first Monday in November every four years, provided that a
10 regular general election day may be set by election resolution on an
11 alternate date when the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November
12 falls on a recognized holiday or a recognized religious holiday or eve.

13 (i) Even-numbered districts elected in the November 2nd, 2027 election
14 shall serve a two-year term and not a four-year term. After that two-
15 year term expires, the Councilors representing even-numbered
16 districts shall be subject to the election dates set forth in Article II,
17 Section 2(C) of this Charter.

18 (C) All Councilors shall be elected by the voters to a four-year term at the
19 regular general election held on November 6th, 2029. Thereafter, regular
20 general elections shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday
21 in November every four years, provided that a regular general election day
22 may be set by election resolution on an alternate date when the first
23 Tuesday after the first Monday in November falls on a recognized holiday
24 or a recognized religious holiday or eve.

25 (D) The Mayor shall be elected by the voters to four-year terms at the regular
26 general election held on November 5th, 2025. Thereafter, regular general
27 elections shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
28 November every four years, provided that a regular general election day
29 may be set by election resolution on an alternate date when the first
30 Tuesday after the first Monday in November falls on a recognized holiday
31 or a recognized religious holiday or eve.]

32 SECTION 2. TIME OF FILING WITH THE CITY CLERK. The Director of City
33 Council Services, or their designee, shall file this Charter Amendment

1 Proposal with the City Clerk upon its final passage.
2 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, word, or
3 phrase of this proposition is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable
4 by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the
5 validity of the remaining provisions of this proposition. The Council hereby
6 declares that it would have passed this proposition and each section,
7 paragraph, sentence, clause, word, or phrase thereof irrespective of any
8 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
9 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This proposition is effective immediately.
10 The Charter Amendment described in SECTION 1 of this proposition shall take
11 effect on January 1, 2025, so long as certified as approved by the voters.
