4 III HONOR GUARD DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM FOR EQUIPMENT NEEDED BY
5 THE ALBUQUERQUE FIRE RESCUE HONOR GUARD AND PROVIDING AN
6 APPROPRIATION TO THE ALBUQUERQUE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN FISCAL
7 YEAR 2026.

8 WHEREAS, Albuquerque Fire Rescue Honor Guard performs flag
9 presentations at promotional ceremonies, cadet graduations, and City of
10 Albuquerque events; and

11 WHEREAS, Albuquerque Fire Rescue Honor Guard renders firefighter
12 honors at funeral and memorial services of fallen firefighters, both locally and
13 nationally; and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque is desirous of appropriating for these
15 funds to assist with replacement of worn uniforms and to acquire needed
16 equipment to perform these duties.

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
18 ALBUQUERQUE:

19 Section 1. That Council hereby approves and authorizes Albuquerque Fire
20 Rescue Department to accept the grant appropriation from the New Mexico
21 Department of Public Safety, 2025 Lt. Fred Beers III Honor Guard Distribution
22 Program in the amount of \$6,387.04 for the period of July 1, 2025 through April
23 30, 2026, and its submission and filing of the award with the appropriate official
24 or office of the New Mexico Department of Public Safety is in all respects
25 approved.

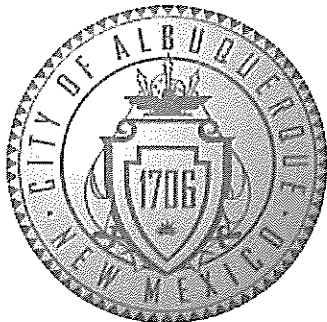

SUBJECT: Approval and authorization of a grant award from the New Mexico Department of Public Safety, 2025 Lt. Fred Beers III Honor Guard Distribution Program and providing an appropriation to the Albuquerque Fire Rescue Department.

For your consideration, please find the attached resolution that will allow Albuquerque Fire Rescue to expend funding through the New Mexico Department of Public Safety, 2025 Lt. Fred Beers III Honor Guard Distribution Program. The grant is designed to provide funding to public safety honor guard programs through the State of New Mexico in order to procure uniforms and equipment for the performance of honor guard details for public safety entities.

The grant appropriation is state funding from the New Mexico Department of Public Safety of \$6,387.04 for the period of July 1, 2025 through April 30, 2026 and \$958.06 for indirect costs covered by City general funds. City matching funds are not required.





Cover Analysis

1. What is it?

A new grant appropriation for the state assistance for the procurement of uniforms and equipment for the Albuquerque Fire Rescue Honor Guard. The goal is to replace worn uniforms, outfit new members, and obtain necessary equipment to provide AFR Honor Guard detail at cadet graduations, promotional ceremonies, and City of Albuquerque events. This will also equip the Honor Guard to provide services at fallen firefighters' funerals and memorial services within the City of Albuquerque, the State of NM, and nationally if called upon to do so.

2. What will this piece of legislation do?

Allow the City to appropriate for state funding from the New Mexico Department of Public Safety, 2025 Lt. Fred Beers III Honor Guard Distribution Program, for the operation of the Albuquerque Fire Rescue Honor Guard.

3. Why is this project needed?

Albuquerque Fire Rescue Honor Guard provides a much-needed service to its members at many different functions, including: cadet graduations, promotional ceremonies, and funeral services. Performing these services inflicts wear and tear on the equipment and uniforms which requires repair or replacement to keep the Albuquerque Fire Rescue Honor Guard looking professional. New members also require uniforms and equipment to perform these duties.

4. How much will it cost and what is the funding source?

The grant award are state funds from the New Mexico Department of Public Safety in the amount of \$6,387.04 and funds of \$958.06 for indirect costs from the Transfer to Operating Grants program in the General Fund.

5. Is there a revenue source associated with this contract? If so, what level of income is projected?

No.

6. What will happen if the project is not approved?

If this project is not approved, the Albuquerque Fire Rescue Honor Guard will provide Honor Guard details on a limited basis and with fewer members. Funding to maintain and replace equipment and uniforms would eventually need to come through the city budget instead of grant funding.

No.
