17 appropriated to the Economic Development Department Operating Grants Fund
18 (265) for Fiscal Years 2024 and 2025.

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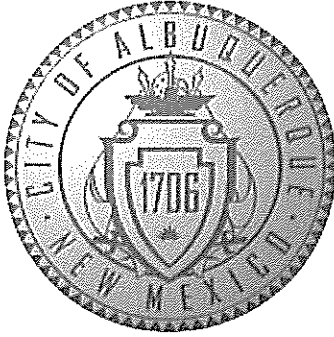




