4 nationally as he represented Sandia National Laboratories on
5 programmatic and policy issues to other companies, U.S. agencies, and

7 WHEREAS, Ed Barsis contributed to the field of engineering physics,
8 working at Sandia National Laboratories in Albuquerque and led an effort in
9 parallel computing, receiving national attention in the New York Times,
10 which resulted in worldwide acceptance of the technology and the
11 development of the largest supercomputer in the world, representing a
12 great achievement for the city of Albuquerque; and

13 WHEREAS, Ed Barsis exemplified citizenship by representing
14 participating organizations in the appropriate forums, engaging with
15 elected officials, actively participating in local government; and

16 WHEREAS, Ed Barsis, an honorable veteran of the U.S. Army,
17 dedicated years of service to Albuquerque and the Four Hills Village
18 residents and worked closely with the City of Albuquerque, inspiring others
19 to continue efforts to promote Four Hills Village as a secure, desirable
20 neighborhood in harmony with the beauty that is the east gateway of
21 Albuquerque.

23 OF ALBUQUERQUE:


24 Section 1. The City Council deems it appropriate and in the public




