1 RESOLUTION

2 EXPRESSING FULL SUPPORT FOR THE ALBUQUERQUE-BERNALILLO  
3 COUNTY (ABC) COMMUNITY SCHOOLS PARTNERSHIP AND FOR THE  
4 COMMUNITY SCHOOLS INITIATIVE

5 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque, the County of Bernalillo and the  
6 Albuquerque Public Schools utilize their combined resources to increase  
7 parent involvement, student academic achievement and overall community  
8 quality of life; and

9 WHEREAS, through the creation and support of collaborative working  
10 relationships with schools and the business community, social service  
11 agencies, government agencies, faith-based organizations, civic groups,  
12 neighborhood associations and post secondary institutions; and

13 WHEREAS, support for the organizations necessary to create an effective  
14 and sustainable Community Schools System is a priority for the City of  
15 Albuquerque; and

16 WHEREAS, a Community School is both a set of partnerships and a place  
17 where services, supports, and opportunities lead to improved student  
18 learning, stronger families, and healthier communities; and

19 WHEREAS, a Community School differs from a traditional school because  
20 the various partners are not conducting business as usual. They are working  
21 together toward common results; changing their funding patterns,  
22 transforming the practice of their staffs, and working creatively and  
23 respectfully with youth, families, and residents to create a different kind of  
24 institution.
