That the City of Albuquerque Aviation Department, Grantee of 25 Foreign-Trade Zone No. 110, is hereby duly authorized to submit an 26 Application to reorganize General Purpose Foreign-Trade Zone No. 110 under

That any subsequent Administrative Actions, such as the addition of a Usage-Driven or Subzone site by Boundary Modification application to be filed at the Foreign-Trade Zones Board relating to this application are also specifically authorized. This authorization will provide the City of Albuquerque Aviation Department with the ability to quickly react to a request by a company under the Alternative Site Framework.
