6 WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Community Safety Department has a goal to  
7 ensure people of all ages have the access to holistic and trauma-infomed  
8 response to calls for services; and

9 WHEREAS, the operation of the Albuquerque Community Safety  
10 Department provides the technical means of accomplishing these goals; and

11 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque is desirous of applying for these funds  
12 to support operations within the community.

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF  
14 ALBUQUERQUE:

15 Section 1. That the attached application for the Pohland Foundation grant  
16 in the amount of \$5,000 for the period of January 1, 2025 through June 30,  
17 2025, is hereby approved and its submission and filing with the appropriate  
18 official or office of the Pohlad Foundation is in all respects approved.

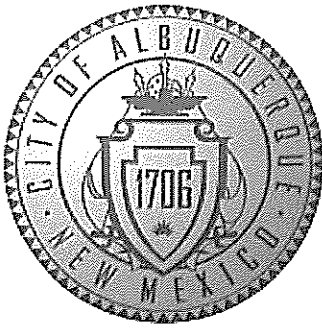
19 Section 2. That in the event that the grant is awarded, state funds from the



## **Cover Analysis**

### **1. What is it?**

A new grant application for non-profit assistance for the operations of Albuquerque Community Safety. The goal is to use this small dollar amount to support operations, materials, or awareness of ACS's role within the community.

### **2. What will this piece of legislation do?**

Allow the City to apply for state funding from the Pohlاد Foundation grant for the operation of ACS's work within the City of Albuquerque.

### **3. Why is the project needed?**

To receive the contribution that the Pohlاد Foundation has generously offered and support ACS.

### **4. How much will it cost and what is the funding source?**

The application is seeking \$5,000 from January 1, 2025 through June 30, 2025. There are no matching funds required for this grant. The funding source is from the Pohlاد Foundation.

### **5. Is there a revenue source associate with this contract? If so, what level of income is projected.**

No, the grant award is the revenue source and no matching funds or General Fund impacts are required, nor City cash match or indirect cost rate requirement.

### **6. What will happen if the project is not approved?**

The partnership with Pohlاد will significantly deteriorate and the Department would have to deny the contribution.
