[FIFTY PERCENT] [NO] MINIMUM VOTE. 21 Those persons who are candidates for Mayor or [Councillor] [Councilor] 22 and receive the largest number of votes cast for the office in question are 23 elected [provided the number of votes equals or exceeds 50% of the 24 total number of votes cast for the office]. 25 Section 8.
