13           ~~(2) Use of a Project Labor Agreement. A project labor agreement~~  
14 ~~shall be utilized in each City public works construction project where the total~~  
15 ~~project cost, is anticipated to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) and~~  
16 ~~where at least three crafts will be employed on the project. This subsection~~  
17 ~~shall apply to all public works construction projects unless the existence of a~~  
18 ~~project labor agreement will jeopardize state, federal or other public funding~~  
19 ~~sources. It shall be set forth in the construction bid documents for the public~~  
20 ~~works construction project, as a condition of the award, that the successful~~

26           ~~(3) Required articles in a project labor agreement. The City shall~~

4           ~~(4) Compliance with state and federal law. This subsection and the~~  
5 ~~use of the project labor agreement shall be enforced only to the extent that it~~  
6 ~~is consistent with the laws of the State of New Mexico and the United States.~~

7           ~~(5) PLA required prior to project award being submitted to City~~  
8 ~~Council. The City Council shall not consider or approve any recommendation~~  
9 ~~of award for any project where a PLA is required, until a PLA has been~~  
10 ~~executed.~~

11          ~~(l) Any and all rules and regulations adopted or promulgated under this~~  
12 ~~provision shall be consistent with and subject to the provisions of this article,~~  
13 ~~and in the event of a conflict between such rules and regulations and this~~  
14 ~~article, this article shall control. REPEALED.”~~

15          **SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, paragraph, sentence,  
16 clause, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or  
17 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not  
18 affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council  
19 hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section,  
20 paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any  
21 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

22          **SECTION 3. COMPILATION.** The ordinance amendment prescribed by  
23 **SECTION 1** shall amend, be incorporated in, and be made part of the Revised  
24 Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico 1994.

25          **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect five days  
26 after publication by title and general summary.

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
