WHEREAS, the Capital Implementation Program of the City of Albuquerque is 6 7 governed by the requirements established under Section 2-12-4 ROA, 1994, which 8 provides for semiannual amendments to the approved program; and WHEREAS, appropriations are needed for various purposes including the Cultural 9 Services, Environmental Health, Facilities, Family & Community Services, Finance 10 Deletion 13 11 Storm, Streets, Fire, Parks, Planning, Police, Senior Affairs, Solid Waste, Transit; and WHEREAS, appropriations are needed for continued improvements at the Sunport; and WHEREAS, Impact Fee revenues now need to be appropriated; and WHEREAS, the appropriations of these various funds to projects within their respective purposes are timely and necessary for the City to serve its citizens.
