R-25-127 **ENACTMENT NO.** SPONSORED BY: Joaquín Baca 1 RESOLUTION 2 ADOPTING A PROPOSITION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT THE NEXT 3 ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE CONCERNING 4 ADOPTING A THREE EIGHTHS OF ONE PERCENT (0.375%) MUNICIPAL GROSS 5 RECEIPTS TAX TO CREATE A QUALITY OF LIFE ENHANCEMENT FUND. 6 WHEREAS, O-25-77 proposes to adopt a three eighths of one percent 7 (0.375%) municipal gross receipts tax to create a Quality of Life Enhancement 8 Fund; and 9 WHEREAS, O-25-77 dedicates all revenue generated by this municipal 10 gross receipts tax to uses that enhance the quality of life of Albuquerque - Deletion 11 residents, such as promoting and preserving cultural diversity; enhancing the Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 quality of cultural programs and activities; fostering greater access to cultural 13 opportunities; promoting culture in order to further economic development Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] 14 within the municipality; and supporting projects, programs, events and 15 organizations with direct, identifiable and measurable public benefit to 16 residents; and 17 WHEREAS, O-25-77 prioritizes utilizing the revenue to complete the North 18 Domingo Baca Aquatic Center, fund the development of a performing arts 19 center, then allocate funds equally among the nine City Council Districts; and 20 WHEREAS, the Municipal Local Option Gross Receipts and Compensating 21 Taxes Act authorizes the imposition of this municipal gross receipts tax by a 22 majority vote of the City Council, or the City Council may choose to require an 23 election to authorize imposition of the tax; and 24 WHEREAS, O-25-77 was approved by a majority vote of the City Council,

and the Council has directed that imposition of this municipal gross receipts

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- 1 tax is contingent upon subsequent approval by the voters of the City of
- 2 Albuquerque; and
- 3 WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of
- 4 Albuquerque to place a question on the ballot of the November 4, 2025
- 5 Regular Local Election regarding whether to adopt this municipal gross
- 6 receipts tax.
- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
- 8 ALBUQUERQUE:
- 9 SECTION 1. The City Clerk is instructed to place the following proposition
- 10 on the 2025 Regular Local Election Ballot, and the qualified voters of the City
- of Albuquerque shall be permitted to vote "yes" or "no." In consultation with 11
- 12 the Bernalillo County Clerk and/ or the Secretary of State, the City Clerk shall
- 13 have the authority modify the proposition as to form to conform with
- 14 applicable law.
