1 RESOLUTION

2 AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF APPLICATIONS WITH THE FEDERAL TRANSIT
3 ADMINISTRATION, AND OPERATING ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED
4 STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FOR FEDERAL
5 TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE AUTHORIZED BY 49 U.S.C. CHAPTER 53;
6 TITLE 23, UNITED STATES CODE; OR OTHER FEDERAL STATUTES
7 ADMINISTERED BY THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION.

8 WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administrator has been delegated authority
9 to award Federal financial assistance for transportation projects; and

10 WHEREAS, the grant or cooperative agreement for Federal financial
11 assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, and may require
12 the applicant to provide the local share of the project cost; and

13 WHEREAS, the applicant has or will provide all annual certifications and
14 assurances to the Federal Transit Administration required for the project.

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
16 ALBUQUERQUE:

17 Section 1. That the Chief Administration Officer is authorized to execute
18 and file applications for Federal assistance on behalf of the City of
19 Albuquerque with the Federal Transit Administration for Federal assistance
20 authorized by 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53; Title 23, United States Code; or other
21 Federal statutes authorizing a project administered by the Federal Transit
22 Administration. The City of Albuquerque is the designated recipient as defined
23 by 49 U.S.C. 5307(a)(2), to apply for Urbanized Area Formula Program
24 assistance.

25 Section 2. That the Chief Administration Officer is authorized to execute
26 and file with its applications the annual certifications and assurances and

1 other documents required by the Federal Transit Administration before
2 awarding a Federal assistance grant or cooperative agreement.

3 Section 3. That the Chief Administration Officer is authorized to execute
4 grant and cooperative agreements with the Federal Transit Administration on
5 behalf of the City of Albuquerque.
