Shall the City of Albuquerque issue \$4,545,000 of its general obligation bonds to plan, design, study, construct, develop, demolish, reconstruct, rehabilitate, renovate, modernize, preserve, secure, expand, equip, landscape, streetscape, repair, enhance, acquire or otherwise improve non-right of way and right of way land, property, facilities or infrastructure owned by the City of Albuquerque for Metropolitan Redevelopment Projects within adopted Metropolitan Redevelopment Areas in order to implement the objectives of the New Mexico Metropolitan Redevelopment Code?

The election on the Bond Election Questions shall be held and Section 6: conducted in accordance with the Election Code and the Bond Election Act.

Section 7: The Bond Election Resolution shall be published in the English and Spanish languages at least once a week for four consecutive weeks by four insertions, the first insertion being published between fifty (50) and sixty (60) days before the day of the Election in a newspaper or newspapers which are of general circulation in the City and which otherwise qualify as legal newspapers in the City.

**Section 8:** For further information concerning this election, consult the Office of the County Clerk, 6th Floor, One Civic Plaza, Albuquerque, New Mexico.

Section 9: The officers of the City be and they hereby are authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution.

**Section 10:** If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provisions shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each section, paragraph, sentence, clause,

word, or phrase thereof irrespective of any provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

**Section 11:** All resolutions and ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any resolution or ordinance, or parts thereof, heretofore repealed.
