• Written Comments: The Committee will take comment on the meeting's specific agenda items in written form via email through 1:00 pm on Monday, May 10th. Web form submission for written comment can be found at

o Note: Participants must sign up for public comment with the Zoom username or phone number that they will be entering the Zoom meeting with so that they can be identified when accessing the meeting.
