WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico and the City of Albuquerque, a 5 municipal subdivision of the State, are charged with providing for the public's 6 7 health, welfare and safety; and WHEREAS, The State of New Mexico and the City of Albuquerque strive to 8 create policies and programs to provide for just and equitable communities 9 and often share missions, and work cooperatively, to provide citizens mental 10 and physical health services, job and food security, and quality civic 11 12 infrastructure; and 13 WHEREAS, many of the facilities provided by, and services offered through, the City of Albuquerque have a regional impact. These facilities and 14 services benefit residents of Albuquerque, Central New Mexico and citizens 15 from throughout the State. To succeed in acquiring the funds to construct and 16 improve these amenities requires a joint effort between the State of New 17 18 Mexico and the City of Albuquerque; and WHEREAS, The City of Albuquerque is one community created through 19 many neighborhoods that require continual investment. Efforts to fund these 20 neighborhood projects are multi-year combined efforts between neighborhood 21 groups, Albuquerque City Councilors, New Mexico State Legislators and often 22 23 Bernalillo County Commissioners.
