ENACTMENT NO. 3-2022-012 COUNCIL BILL NO R-22-4 SPONSORED BY: Isaac Benton, by request 1 RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR 2 THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE AND BERNALILLO COUNTY. 3 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque is vulnerable to natural hazards such 4 as flash floods, wildfire, and drought as well as human-caused hazards that 5 can result in loss of life, property loss, economic hardship, and threats to 6 7 public health and safety; and WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has 8 required that every municipality and county have a pre-disaster mitigation 9 10 plan in place, and requires municipalities to adopt such plans in order to be Bracketed/Strikethrough Material - Deletion eligible to receive funding from the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program; and 11 [Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New WHEREAS, a Hazard Mitigation Plan is a community's plan for evaluating 12 hazards, identifying resources and capabilities, selecting appropriate 13 actions, and developing and implementing the preferred mitigation actions to 14 eliminate or reduce future damage in order to protect the health, safety and 15 16 welfare of the residents in that community; and WHEREAS, in 2007, the City Council adopted the 2007 Bernalillo County 17 and City of Albuquerque Hazard Mitigation Plan pursuant to Resolution R-07-18 19 288, enactment No. R-2007-091; and WHEREAS, in 2015, the City Council approved an update to the Bernalillo 20 21 County and City of Albuquerque Hazard Mitigation Plan pursuant to 22 Resolution R-15-236, enactment No. R-2015-087; and WHEREAS, a 2021 update to the Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Hazard 23 Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Mitigation Planning Team, which 24 includes representatives from the City's Office of Emergency Management 25

	•	and bernamio County Emergency Management Office as well as several
	2	other local entities; and
	3	WHEREAS, several public meetings were held throughout 2021 to develop
	4	and review changes to the proposed Hazard Mitigation Plan; and
	5	WHEREAS, the Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Hazard Mitigation Plan, a
	6	copy of which is attached to this resolution, identifies potential natural and
	7	human-caused hazards and assesses their risks; sets forth goals, objectives
	8	and mitigation actions; and sets forth a mitigation plan and implementation
	9	strategy to protect City and County residents.
