SECTION 4. 2023 ELECTION. That the areas established by Exhibit A as the
nine Council Districts are for the purposes of Municipal Elections starting with
the 2023 regular local election and all subsequent Municipal Elections until the
next redistricting; for all other purposes, the effective date for the Council
Districts created by Exhibit A is the effective date of this ordinance. Each of
the current incumbents in the nine Council Districts will remain in office until
the expiration of the term to which he or she was elected.
SECTION 5. COMMITTEE REPORT. For the purpose of maintaining records
of the activities and recommendations of the Redistricting Committee, the
Redistricting Committee Report is hereby received and incorporated herein as
if set out in full, via OC-22-13.
SECTION 6. PRECINTS. For the purpose of identifying the precincts in each
Council District, a listing of precincts identifying Council Districts by precinct
is attached as part of Exhibit A and is incorporated herein as if set out in full
and is hereby adopted as to precincts.
SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence,
clause, word or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or
unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not
affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Council
hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section,
paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any
provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
SECTION 8. COMPILATION. Exhibit 'A' shall amend, update and replace
Appendix 'A' of the Albuquerque City Charter.
SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect five days
after publication by title and general summary.
