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1 WHEREAS there is only one pool in Northwest Albuquerque and it is
2 owned by the County (Paradise Hills) and there are no City-owned pools in
3 District Five; and

4 WHEREAS, there are currently two multi-Generational centers in the City
5 and both are on Albuquerque’s East Side; and

6 WHEREAS, design plans for a multi-generational center for District Five are
7 currently underway; and

8 WHEREAS, Albuquerque’s Westside residents should have equal access to
9 the amenities that the City provides; and

10 WHEREAS, Cibola Loop is close to a high school, a police station, a fire
11 station, and residential neighborhoods, making it a perfect location for
12 community amenities.

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
14 ALBUQUERQUE:

15 SECTION 1. The Department of Finance and Administrative Services
16 (DFAS) is directed to work with the Department of Family and Community
17 Services (FCS) for the purpose of repaying the Federal Department of Housing
18 and Urban Development (HUD) related to the development of the Cibola Loop
19 Affordable Housing Project, as the land purchased by funds will no longer be
20 used for an Eligible Use of the Community Block Development Grant, as
21 defined by HUD

22 SECTION 2. The following appropriation is made from the available fund
23 balance in the following program for Fiscal Year 2023:
