1 RESOLUTION  
2 DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND COMMUNITY SERVICES TO  
3 REDESIGNATE FUNDS DESIGNATED FOR SAFE OUTDOOR SPACES TO USE  
4 TO SUPPORT HOMELESS, NEAR HOMELESS, OR PRECARIOUSLY HOUSED  
5 VETERANS IN FISCAL YEAR 2023, BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022 AND ENDING  
6 JUNE 30, 2023; AMENDING THE 2021 TWO YEAR CAPITAL BUDGET TO  
7 REDESIGNATE FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR HOMELESS ENCAMPMENTS.

8 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Albuquerque requires the Mayor to  
9 formulate the annual operating budget for the City of Albuquerque; and

10 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Albuquerque requires the Council to  
11 approve or amend and approve the Mayor's budget; and

12 WHEREAS, C/S R-22-24, passed by the Council on May 16, 2022,  
13 appropriated the operating budget of the City of Albuquerque for Fiscal Year  
14 2023; and

15 WHEREAS, this Resolution proposes to make adjustments to certain  
16 appropriations; and

17 WHEREAS, appropriations for the operation of the City government must  
18 be approved by the Council; and

19 WHEREAS, the Council originally appropriated \$750,000 to the Homeless  
20 Support Services program in the Family and Community Services Department  
21 for the purposes of Safe Outdoor Spaces; and

22 WHEREAS, the Council wishes for \$750,000 to remain in the Homeless  
23 Support Services program, but to be designated to support homeless, near  
24 homeless, or precariously housed Veterans.

25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF  
26 ALBUQUERQUE:

1 SECTION 1. Funding in the amount of \$750,000 appropriated to the Family  
2 and Community Services Department, Homeless Support Services program in  
3 the General Fund (110) for Safe Outdoor Spaces in Fiscal Year 2023, is hereby  
4 re-designated to instead provide funding for general support, including, but  
5 not limited to housing and shelter services for homeless, near homeless, or  
6 precariously housed veterans in the City. This funding shall not be used  
7 directly or indirectly for any Safe Outdoor Space.

8 SECTION 2. The following amounts are hereby appropriated within the 2021  
9 Capital Budget:

10 Community Facilities/Family & Community Services

11 Homeless Encampments	(\$500,000)
12 Metropolitan Gateway Facility Renovations	\$500,000
