2	FORMALIZING THE CITY'S URBAN TREE CANOPY GRANT PROGRAM.	
3	WHEREAS, promoting and protecting the City's urban tree	
4	canopy advances the health, safety and welfare of the City through	
5	beautification, and by helping remove pollutants from the air, soil, and	
6	water, and by helping mitigate urban heat island effects; and	
7	WHEREAS, the City Council has for several years funded and promot	ed
8	the "NeighborWoods" community tree planting pilot program led by Tree No	
9	Mexico; and	
10	WHEREAS, the pilot program has been successful in expanding the	
11	City's urban tree canopy by working directly with neighborhood groups to	
12	organize and implement the planting of street trees; and	
13	WHEREAS, in addition to advancing these important purposes, the	
14	community-based approach to the NeighborWoods program has also	
15	promoted community development by organizing and investing neighbors a	ınd
16	neighborhood groups in the wellbeing of the trees within their communities;

18	WHEREAS, the NeighborWoods program has been historically funded	l
19	through City Councilor District set asides in the participating districts and	
20	funding from the Parks and Recreation Department, and can continue to be	
21	viable in all areas and districts of the City where funding is made available;

23	WHEREAS, the City has launched the "Let's Plant Albuquerque"	
24	nitiative to coordinate and increase tree planting across the City in order to	
	naintain and expand the urban forest canopy: and	

- WHEREAS, the NeighborWoods program and other tree planting efforts 1 are making and will continue to make important contributions to the "Let's 2 3 Plant Albuquerque" initiative: and 4 WHEREAS, given the success of the NeighborWoods pilot program, the purpose of this resolution is to establish a formal Urban Tree Canopy Grant 5 Program to continue urban tree planting efforts, including but not limited to 6 the NeighborWoods program, while expanding funding opportunities for 7 additional urban forestry tree planting projects and initiatives. 8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 9 10 **ALBUQUERQUE:** 11 **SECTION 1. Grant Program Established:** The City's Urban Tree Canopy Grant Program ("Program") is established as 12 a grant program of the City to fund contracts with civic groups, to provide 13 community services related to tree planting and maintenance. The Parks and 14 Recreation Department will administer the Program and oversee contracts 15 funded through the Program for the purpose of completing tree planting and 16 17 related services ("Projects"). Work on Projects will include, but not be limited to the following: 18 · Working with neighborhoods or other identified areas throughout the 19 City to select planting sites consistent with Sections 6-6-2-1 et. seq. ROA 1994, 20 the Street Trees Ordinance, and other laws; 21 Recruiting and training volunteers from Project areas; 22 23 Conducting tree inventories and mapping Project areas; Coordinating tree species selection, and the purchase, delivery, 24 planting, and mulching of trees; 25 Providing traffic control measures during Project activities; 26 Providing excavation, digging, and irrigation services; 27 28 · Providing supplies for each Project; Providing on-going support on tree maintenance and irrigation for 29 30 completed Projects: Tracking Project area tree inventories to reflect new plantings; 31
- Other activities in furtherance of restoring or expanding the urban tree canopy; and

2	SECTION 2. Funding. The Urban Tree Canopy Grant Program will be funded
3	through Councilor District set asides from participating districts, or through
4	specific appropriations of the Council.
5	SECTION 3. The Parks and Recreation Department shall develop an
6	application process that makes funding available for grant awards to Tree New
7	Mexico for its Neighborwoods program, and any other qualified grantees, by
8	no later than January 1, 2023.
