R-2022-016 SPONSORED BY: Trudy Jones, by request 1 RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS 2 BASED ON THE ATTACHED APPLICATION FROM THE NEW MEXICO AGING 3 AND LONG TERM SERVICES DEPARTMENT FOR STATE ASSISTANCE FROM 4 THE NEW MEXICO LOCAL GROWN PRODUCE GRANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF 5 PROVIDING SENIORS WITH NUTRITIOUS MEALS FROM FOOD THAT IS 6 GROWN IN NEW MEXICO AND PROVIDING FOR AN APPROPRIATION TO THE 7 DEPARTMENT OF SENIOR AFFAIRS IN FISCAL YEAR 2023. 8 9 WHEREAS, the Aging and Long Term Services Department announced a grant opportunity in April 2022 that was open to New Mexico Senior Centers or 10 Bracketed/Strikethrough Material-1 - Deletion [+Bracketed/Underscored Material+] - New 11 Nutrition Sites that provide meals to older adults that meet all requirements specified in the Older American Act; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Department of Senior Affairs has developed a coordinated delivery system of providing older adults with meal services that 14 meet the needs of older adults of Albuquerque and Bernalillo County and the 15 16 Older American Act; and 17 WHEREAS, the City has applied for State assistance from the Aging and Long Term Services Department for funds in the amount of \$150,482; and 18 WHEREAS, the Aging and Long Term Services Department has allocated 19 funds in the amount of \$150,482 to the Department of Senior Affairs to help 20 meet the nutritional needs of older adults; and 21 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque will contribute funds of \$18,359 which **22** 23 will be used for indirect costs; and WHEREAS, the total allocation for the grant is \$168,841. 24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 25 26 **ALBUQUERQUE:**
