

**SUBJECT:** Accepting an award from Bernalillo County to increase emergency shelter beds for families with children experiencing homelessness in Albuquerque and providing an appropriation to the Department of Family and Community Services, beginning in Fiscal Year 2023.

This is a Resolution approving an award from Bernalillo County to increase emergency shelter beds for families with children experiencing homelessness in Albuquerque and providing an appropriation to the Department of Family and Community Services, beginning in Fiscal Year 2023.

The City and County executed an Intergovernmental Agreement, in which the County agrees to pay the City \$500,000 to be used for the renovation of a facility to provide emergency shelter services for families with children.

The City has already appropriated \$500,000 to Family Promise to be used for the renovation of a facility to provide emergency shelter services for families with children in R-22-24 (the FY23 budget resolution).

This Resolution will award the \$500,000 in Bernalillo County funds to Family Promise to be used for the renovation of a facility to provide emergency shelter services for families with children.

### **Cover Analysis**

#### 1. What is it?

This is a resolution that accepts an award from Bernalillo County to increase emergency shelter beds for families experiencing homelessness and provides an appropriation to the Department of Family and Community Services, beginning in Fiscal Year 2023.

#### 2. What will this piece of legislation do?

This is a resolution that accepts a \$500,000 award from Bernalillo County to increase emergency shelter beds for families experiencing homelessness. The resolution appropriates the funds to the Department of Family and Community Services (DFCS), beginning in Fiscal Year 2023. The resolution directs FCS to award the funds to Family Promise for the renovation of a facility to provide emergency shelter services for families with children.

#### 3. Why is this project needed?

There are not enough emergency shelter beds for families with children in Albuquerque.

#### 4. How much will it cost and what is the funding source?

The City entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Bernalillo County, in which the County agrees to pay the City \$500,000 to be used for the renovation of a facility to provide emergency shelter services for families with children. Under the IGA the City agrees to provide a \$500,000 match; the \$500,000 matching funds were already appropriated in the FY23 budget, as a one-time appropriation to Family Promise.

# 5. Is there a revenue source associated with this contract? If so, what level of income is projected?

This resolution is accepting a \$500,000 award from Bernalillo County. This project will not generate any income.

#### 6. What will happen if the project is not approved?

Family Promise will not receive funding to renovate a facility to provide emergency shelter services for families with children, and will not be able to increase the number of emergency shelter beds available for families.

#### 7. Is this service already provided by another entity?

There are other emergency shelters that serve families with children in Albuquerque. However, there are not enough shelter beds to meet the need.
