1 RESOLUTION
2 ACCEPTING AN AWARD FROM BERNALILLO COUNTY TO INCREASE
3 EMERGENCY SHELTER BEDS FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN
4 EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS IN ALBUQUERQUE AND PROVIDING AN
5 APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND COMMUNITY
6 SERVICES, BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2023.

7 WHEREAS, the City and County desire to work together to increase
8 emergency shelter beds for families with children experiencing homelessness;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the City and County executed an Intergovernmental
11 Agreement; in which the County agrees to pay the City Five Hundred
12 Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), which amount will be used for the renovation
13 of a facility to provide emergency shelter services for families with children;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, the City agrees to provide matching funds in the amount of
16 Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) for the renovation of a facility to
17 provide emergency shelter for families with children; and

18 WHEREAS, City Resolution R-22-24 (Enactment No. R-2022-036)
19 appropriated \$500,000 in City General Funds to the Department of Family and
20 Community Services (DFCS) to Family Promise, to be used for the renovation
21 of a facility to provide emergency shelter services for families with children.

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY
23 OF ALBUQUERQUE:

24 Section 1. That the \$500,000 award from Bernalillo County is hereby
25 approved.


