COUNCIL BILL NO. 0-23-72 ENACTMENT NO. 0-2023-012 SPONSORED BY: Isaac Benton by request 1 **ORDINANCE** ADOPTING A TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT 2 ORDINANCE FOR THE NORTH 4TH CORRIDOR CHARACTER PROTECTION 3 OVERLAY ZONE (CPO-9) SMALL MAPPED AREA RELATED TO THE 4 APPLICABILITY SETBACK AND STEPBACK REQUIREMENTS. 5 WHEREAS, the North 4th Corridor Character Protection Overlay Zone (CPO-6 9) was established in 2020 as a part of the 2019 IDO Annual Update; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the intention of CPO-9 is to facilitate and encourage development along 4th Street that has an urban, walkable character; and 9 WHEREAS, CPO-9 has a building stepback requirement and a building 10 Bracketed/Strikethrough-Material] - Deletion setback requirement that seek to create an adequate pedestrian realm directly 11 Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 along 4th Street; and WHEREAS, the stepback and setback requirements are only applicable to 13 14 the "front" of a development, as currently written; and WHEREAS, the language as written could offer an unintended 15 16 consequence of not applying the appropriate stepback or setback if a building is being constructed on a corner lot or a full block where the "front" of the 17 structure could be turned to a side-street that is not 4th Street; and 18 WHEREAS, the proposed text amendment will ensure that the stepback and 19 setback are always appropriately provided along 4th Street; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the Environmental Planning Commission considered this request on December 8th, 2022 and forwarded to the City Council a 22 recommendation of approval subject to the findings in the record. 23 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 24 25 **ALBUQUERQUE:**

SECTION 1. Amend the 3-6(J)(2) and 3-6(J)(3)(b) in the CPO-9 in the IDO as 1 2 follows: 3 3-4(J)(2) Site and Setback Standards Lot size, width, usable open space, and setbacks shall be provided according 4 to the applicable standards in Section 14-16-5-1 (Dimensional Standards), with 5 6 the exception of the following: 7 3-4(J)(2)(a) Any setback from a lot line abutting 4th Street, minimum: 10 feet. 3-4(J)(2)(b) Any setback from a lot line abutting 4th Street, maximum: 15 8 9 feet. 10 3-4(J)(3)(b) Building Stepback Any portion of a building over 30 feet tall shall incorporate a minimum 11 stepback of 6 feet from any façade facing 4th street, a public street. 12 SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence, 13 clause, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or 14 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not 15 affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council 16 hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid. SECTION 3. COMPILATION. Sections 1 of this ordinance shall be incorporated in and made part of the Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994. SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect after publication by title and general summary upon the sooner of the effective date of the 2022 IDO Annual Update or January 31st, 2024.
