BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 5 6 **ALBUQUERQUE:** 7 SECTION 1. Section 2-12-1 of the Capital Improvements Program Ordinance 8 is amended as follows: "§ 2-12-1 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM INTENT; SCOPE. 9 10 (Q) 1. \$13.5 million of the 2025 General Obligation Bond Program is Deletion reserved for a Council district set-aside to be divided equally amongst 11 Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 the nine City Councilors: |Bracketed/Strikethrough-Material| - | 2. \$15.75 million of the 2027 General Obligation Bond Program is 13 reserved for a Council district set-aside to be divided equally amongst 14 15 the nine City Councilors; and 16 3. \$18 million of the 2029 General Obligation Bond Program, and all subsequent programs, is reserved for a Council district set-aside to 17 be divided equally amongst the nine City Councilors." 18 SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence, 19 clause, word, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid 20 or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall 21 not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The 22 Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each 23 section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word, or phrase thereof irrespective of 24 any provisions being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid. 25
