3 C. The survey results and other evaluation materials shall be deemed  
4 letters or memoranda that matters of opinion in personnel files and exempt from  
5 the Inspection of Public Records Act. The surveys or other evaluation materials  
6 shall not be retained after the Council presents its findings in a public written  
7 report to the Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer.”

8 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause,  
9 word or phrase of this Rules Amendment is for any reason held to be invalid  
10 or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall  
11 not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Rules Amendment.  
12 The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Rules Amendment  
13 and each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof  
14 irrespective of any provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise  
15 invalid.

16 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This rules amendment shall take effect  
17 immediately upon adoption.
