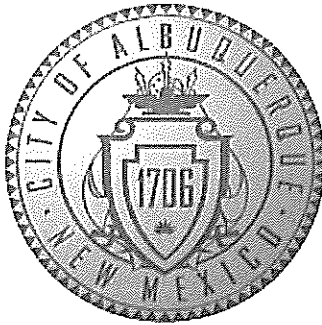

SUBJECT: Executive Communication – Report of All Grant Applications for July-December 2024






