10	the Council set aside funding from the 2007 General Obligation bond program,
11	is amended as follows:

20	Park Improvements & Amenities, is to be used to provide funding for the

23	Section 3. That \$77,000 in funding from Project Number 7353140, District 9
24	Community/Senior Center Enhancements Project, is to be used to provide
25	funding for the design, engineering, construction, equipping, furnishing and
