Cover Analysis

1. What is it?

The Child Care Food Program is a state funded program that provides reimbursement for nutritious meals and snacks served to children who attend the twenty-four (24) child development centers operated by the City of Albuquerque, department of Family and Community Services/Division of Child and Family Development.

2. What will this piece of legislation do?

Approve and authorize the filing of a grant application for a food service program for children with the New Mexico Department of Children, Youth and Families and provide an appropriation to the Department of Family and Community Services/Division of Child and Family Development.
