COUNCIL BILL NO. \_\_\_\_\_ ENACTMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_ SPONSORED BY: 1 RESOLUTION 2 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF THE ATTACHED GRANT 3 APPLICATION FOR THE 2009 DRUG RECOGNITION EXPERT (DRE) PROGRAM WITH THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, 4 TRAFFIC SAFETY BUREAU AND PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE 5 6 CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE. 7 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque has as one of its goals to enhance 8 local law enforcement efforts thereby providing for the public safety and 9 welfare; and 10 WHEREAS, the DRE program is a nationally recognized program by the -Bracketed/Strikethrough Material-] - Deletion 11 National Highway and Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) to certify law 12 enforcement officers statewide in the detection and apprehension of drug 13 impaired drivers; and 14 WHEREAS, the purpose of the 2009 DRE grant is to increase the number of 15 certified DRE officers and provides the officers with the necessary training 16 and equipment to conduct drug impaired evaluations on individuals suspected 17 of driving under the influence of illegal or prescription drugs; and 18 WHEREAS, grant funds in the amount of \$96,653 for this purpose are 19 requested from the State of New Mexico Department of Transportation, Traffic 20 Safety Bureau; and 21 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque is desirous of applying for these funds 22 for which indirect costs of \$704 and FICA charges of \$174 are required to 23 support this grant and are available in the FY/09 Transfer to Operating Grants 24 Fund Program in the General Fund. 25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 26 **ALBUQUERQUE:** 

1	Section 1. That the attached grant application for the 2009 Drug
2	Recognition Expert Program is hereby made a part of this resolution and is
3	hereby approved and its submission and filing with the appropriate official or
4	office of the State of New Mexico, Department of Transportation, Traffic Safety
5	Bureau is in all respects approved.
6	Section 2. That upon award, funds in the amount of \$96,653 from the State
7	of New Mexico Department of Transportation, Traffic Safety Bureau and
8	indirect costs of \$704 and FICA charges of \$174 from the FY09 Transfer to
9	Operating Grants Fund Program in the General Fund are hereby appropriated
10	to the Albuquerque Police Department for the Drug Recognition Expert
11	Program.
