	11	20%+ average increase; and
	12	WHEREAS, this is the largest nominal dollar increase that PNM has ever
	13	sought and the largest percentage increase for at least the past 20 years; and
	14	WHEREAS, the PRC granted rate increases in 2008, 2009 and 2010 for a
	15	total of 44.5% over the past three years; and
	16	WHEREAS, beyond the noted base rate increase, it is anticipated that PNM
	17	will seek other increases through its fuel, energy efficiency and renewable
	18	riders over the next two year period; and
	19	WHEREAS, New Mexico is experience a statewide unemployment rate of
	20	8.5%; and
	21	WHEREAS, the State (Government) or New Mexico has made drastic cuts in
	. 22	spending including schools, colleges and universities; State employee salary
	23	reductions; State employee workforce reduction; and
