	6	Association and the Police Oversight Commission regarding such selection
	7	and subject to approval of such selection by the Albuquerque City Council.
	8	Section 2. The expert shall be retained to create a written report with
	9	recommendations regarding appropriate training with respect to the use of
	10	deadly force based on "best practices" after a nationwide review.
	11	Section 3. The expert shall be retained to create a written report with
	12	recommendations regarding improvements to policies and procedures,
	13	including Standard Operating Procedures, with respect to training in the use
	14	of deadly force based on "best practices" after a nationwide review.
	15	Section 4. The goal of the two reports shall not be to criticize existing
	16	training practices but to ensure that the Albuquerque Police Department
