Trudy Jones, Brad Winter SPONSORED BY: RESOLUTION 1 PROVIDING FUNDING FOR THE PARTY PATROL PROGRAM IN FY/11. 2 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque has as one of its goals to enhance 3 local law enforcement efforts thereby providing for the public safety and 4 5 welfare; and WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque is committed to providing law 6 enforcement to combat underage drinking by reducing alcohol-related 7 crashes, injuries, and deaths; and 8 WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Police Department's Party Patrol Program is a 9 comprehensive enforcement, prevention and education program designed to 10 prevent underage drinking and the serious consequences that can follow; and 11 Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] - Deletion WHEREAS, the program has been extremely successful, as demonstrated 12 Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 13 by the following data: • In the past year there has been a 33% decrease of Misdemeanor 14 "Minor in Possession" citations issued by Party Patrol Teams for 15 underage drinking. 16 • Out of 425 locations checked, only 23 sold alcohol to our minors, 17 which represents a 94.5% compliance rate - one of the best years 18 19 ever. • Out of 676 individuals contacted, 14 agreed they had purchased 20 alcohol for a minor. This resulted in felony arrests and a rate of 21 compliance of about 98.0%; and 22 WHEREAS, in addition, the Party Patrol works with community partners 23 and volunteers to distribute educational materials to individuals of all ages at 24

major community events; and

	3	course of the year, the APD Party Patrol has made presentations to about
	4	2,500 students in the metropolitan area; and

	6	Patrol is essential to the safety of Albuquerque's young people; and
	7	WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available within the City Council Projects
	8	project, activity number 7299990, within Fund 305 in order to provide funding
