WHEREAS, commercial and recreational trapping of "furbearing" animals 6 7 using hidden steel-jaw leghold traps, strangulation snares, and kill-type 8 animal traps is permitted on almost all of New Mexico's public lands; and 9 WHEREAS, the use of steel-jaw leghold traps, strangulation snares, and 10 kill-type animal traps on public lands results in the unnecessary pain, suffering, maiming and killing of untold numbers of "nontarget" animals, 11 [Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] - Deletion Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 including domestic dogs, cats, rabbits, deer, songbirds, eagles, owls, hawks, 13 river otters and threatened and endangered species; and 14 WHEREAS, millions of people, 89 countries, several U.S. states, and 15 numerous municipalities and organizations, including the Humane Society of 16 the United States, the American Veterinarian Association, the American Animal Hospital Association, the World Veterinary Association, and the 17 18 National Animal Control Association, have declared steel-jaw leghold traps to 19 be inhumane: and 20 WHEREAS, trappers in New Mexico are not required to and do not warn the 21 public of the specific or general location of the steel-jaw leghold traps, 22 strangulation snares, and kill-type animal traps they hide on public lands; and 23 WHEREAS, humans have suffered injuries and companion and other 24 nontarget animals have been injured, maimed and killed by hidden and 25 unmarked steel-jaw leghold traps, strangulation snares, and kill-type animal

traps on public lands in New Mexico; and
