2	DETERRING	THE SALE OF VAP	OR PRODUCTS.	
3	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF			
4	ALBUQUER	QUE:		
5	SECTION 1. The Sale of Vapor Products to Children Ordinance is hereby			
6	adopted to read as follows:			
7	"Section 1. SHORT TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known and may be			
8	cited as the 'Sale of Vapor Products to Children Ordinance.'			
9	Section 2. PURPOSE			
10	The use of vapor products has doubled among middle and high school			
11	students from 2011 to 2012. A survey by the Centers for Disease Control and			
12	Prevention found that about one in ten high school students admitted to using			
13	vapor products. The city can implement protections faster than the State or			
14	Federal government. The city can adapt more quickly to changes to the			
15	products that the manufacturers or vendors may make to take their products			
16	outside the scope of this ordinance. Council finds it is reasonable to conclude			
17	that the use of vapor products is a gateway to the use of tobacco products			
18	which are extremely detrimental to the health of all persons, particularly			
19	children.			
20	Section 3	B. DEFINITIONS		
21	CHILD or	CHILDREN shall me	ean persons under 18 years of age. The	
22	singular and plural shall include one another.			
23	ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE means any product or device containing			
24	or delivering nicotine or any other similar substance intended for human			
25	consumptio	n that can be used b	y a person to simulate smoking through	

inhalation of vapor, vapor product or aerosol. Electronic smoking device

1	includes any component part of such product or device whether or not sold
2	separately, including but not limited to vapor products. "Electronic smoking
3	device" does not include any product that has been approved by the United
4	States Food and Drug Administration for sale as a tobacco cessation product
5	and is being marketed and sold solely for the approved purpose.
6	VAPOR PRODUCT means any product or substance that contains nicotine
7	or a similar substance, and is intended for human consumption or is likely to
8	be consumed using an electronic smoking device. "Vapor product" does not
9	include any product specifically approved by the U.S. Food and Drug
10	Administration for sale as a tobacco cessation product that is being marketed
11	and sold solely for the approved purpose.
12	Section 4. VIOLATION
13	It is a crime punishable pursuant to section 1-1-99 of this code of
14	ordinances for any person or entity to sell, offer to sell, barter or give any
15	electronic smoking device or vapor product to any child in the city limits of the
16	City of Albuquerque."
17	Section 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence,
18	clause, word or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or
19	unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not
20	affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Council
21	hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section,
22	paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any
23	provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
24	Section 3. COMPILATION. This Ordinance shall be incorporated in and
25	made part of the Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994.
26	Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect five days
27	after publication by title and general summary.
