(C) A representative of the Council shall be allowed to attend the meetings during which the Mayor and CAO formally review the program recommendations by the CIP Review Group or other similar body. SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid." SECTION 3. COMPILATION. The ordinance amendment prescribed by SECTION 1 shall amend, be incorporated in and made part of the Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994. SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five days after publication by title and general summary.
