R. 2014-023 COUNCIL BILL NO. \_\_R-14-39 SPONSORED BY: Brad Winter 1 RESOLUTION 2 AMENDING THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE CODE OF RESOLUTIONS 3 SECTIONS PERTAINING TO THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL IN CITY 4 PARKS, RECREATIONAL FACILITIES AND OPEN SPACE LANDS. 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 6 ALBUQUERQUE: 7 SECTION 1. The City of Albuquerque Code of Resolutions § 6-5-1 8 (Resolution 257-1978, as amended) designating certain neighborhood parks 9 where alcohol consumption is prohibited, is hereby repealed and deleted. 10 SECTION 2. The City of Albuquerque Code of Resolutions § 6-5-2 (Resolution 67-1982, as amended) designating public areas where drinking 11 - Deletion Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 alcohol is permitted, is hereby amended as follows: 13 "(A) For the purposes of the provisions contained in the Criminal Code Bracketed/Strikethrough Material 14 relating to drinking in public, the consumption of alcohol liquors ("Alcoholic 15 Beverages"), as that term is defined in Section 13-2-2 ROA 1994, is prohibited 16 in all City parks except for the following public park and recreation areas 17 designated as those where the consumption of Alcoholic Beverages is 18 permitted: 19 (1) Los Altos Park, but only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 20 10:00 p.m., except that no consumption of Alcoholic Beverages will be allowed 21 in the swimming pool and skate park areas; 22 **(2)** U.S.S. Bullhead Park, but only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. 23 and 10:00 p.m.; 24 Balloon Fiesta Park; (3) 25 (4) Isotopes Park; 26 (5) **New Mexico Veterans Memorial:**

14	Beverages may be sold, served or consumed at any park, open space, or other						
15	city recreation location, including but not limited to Civic Plaza or any park						
16	hosting Summerfest, during special events if specifically permitted pursuant						
17	to the terms of any Special Event Permit, Park Use Agreement, or other valid						
18	permit issued by the City. Alcoholic Beverages may be sold, served or						
19	consumed at such other municipal facilities where the city in the future						
20	obtains governr	obtains governmental liquor licenses, only in accordance with the laws					
21	applicable to governmental liquor licenses, the terms of any lease agreements						
22	between the city and its tenants or facility users and such others reasonable						
23	rules, regulations, and policies regarding said facilities as the city may adopt						
24	from time to time.						
25	(C) All oth	er developed public parks and recreation areas not designated					

- (C) All other developed public parks and recreation areas not designated in division (A) above will be posted as not permitting the drinking of Alcoholic Beverages."
- SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each section,
