| 21 | Section 1. The Director of Council Services is hereby authorized to enter                |  |  |
| 22 | into an agreement with a consultant to assist the Task Force to be created               |  |  |
| 23 | pursuant to M-14-5 in studying and assessing the gaps in the City, County and            |  |  |
| 24 | State's provision of services for mental health service.                                 |  |  |
| 25 | Section 2. Thirty five thousand dollars (\$35,000) is hereby appropriated                |  |  |
| 26 | within the General Fund (110) to the Council Services Department in FY/14 to             |  |  |
| 27 | carry out the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution.                                |  |  |
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
