1 RESOLUTION

2 DESIGNATING FISCAL YEAR 2015 GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS FOR  
3 SPONSORSHIP OF THE DOWNTOWN BIKE SHARE PILOT PROJECT AND  
4 AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF COUNCIL SERVICES TO ENTER INTO AN  
5 AGREEMENT FOR THIS PURPOSE.

6 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque has as one of its desired community  
7 conditions to provide safe and affordable integrated transportation options  
8 that meet the public's needs; and

9 WHEREAS, the DowntownABQ MainStreet Initiative has organized a pilot  
10 Downtown Bike Share program; and

11 WHEREAS, many cities have used bike share programs as a way to  
12 generate excitement and provide opportunities for residents and visitors to  
13 explore areas of interest in urban centers while reducing vehicle congestion;  
14 and

15 WHEREAS, bike share systems can raise driver awareness of bicyclists  
16 using roadway facilities in congested areas; and

17 WHEREAS, a pilot system will allow the City to assess operational costs  
18 and user interest in such a facility before taking on the long-term ownership  
19 and maintenance responsibilities for such a facility; and

20 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to sponsor the pilot Downtown Bike  
21 Share Program.

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF  
23 ALBUQUERQUE:

24 SECTION 1. That the following designation is hereby made from the  
25 existing General Fund program strategy for operating City government in  
26 fiscal year 2015:
