1 RESOLUTION
2 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR
3 TRANSPORTATION DEMAND MANAGEMENT PROGRAM WITH THE FEDERAL
4 TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF
5 TRANSPORTATION AND PROVIDING FOR AN APPROPRIATION TO THE
6 TRANSIT DEPARTMENT.

7 WHEREAS, Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds in the
8 amount of \$709,766 are available from the U.S. Department of Transportation;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency has classified the City of
11 Albuquerque and Bernalillo County as a "maintenance area" for carbon
12 monoxide; and

13 WHEREAS, the Transportation Demand Management Program is one of the
14 projects identified in the 2016-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
15 that will ultimately provide another type of transit service within the
16 Albuquerque Urbanized Area; and

17 WHEREAS, the encouragement of the use of alternative transportation to
18 improve air quality and decrease traffic congestion has been identified as a
19 program strategy related to Goal 3 on Public Infrastructure of the City's Five-
20 Year Goals Plan; and

21 WHEREAS, the City desires to accept these funds which requires a cash
22 match in the amount of \$120,953 from the FY16 Transfer to Operating Grants
23 Program in the General Fund which includes the City's portion of Indirect
24 Overhead (IDOH).

25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
26 ALBUQUERQUE:

1 Section 1. That the attached application to aid for financing of public
2 transportation projects pursuant to 49 U.S.C., 5307 with the Federal Transit
3 Administration of the U.S. Department of Transportation in the amount of
4 \$709,766 is hereby approved, and its acceptance and filing with the
5 appropriate official or office is in all respects approved.

6 Section 2. That upon award, funds in the amount of \$830,719 consisting of
7 \$709,766 in federal funds from the Federal Transit Administration which
8 include \$63,782 for IDOH, and \$120,953 from the FY16 Transfer to Operating
9 Grants Fund Program in the General Fund which includes \$10,869 for IDOH is
10 hereby appropriated to the Transit Department in the Operating Grants fund
11 265 for Fiscal Year 2016.


