	16	opportunities for persons aged fifty-five (55) and over to participate more fully					
	17	in the life of their communities through significant volunteer service; and					
	18	WHEREAS, the Corporation for National and Community Service has					
	19	allocated funds of \$44,223 for April 1, 2016 - March 30, 2017 and the New					
	20	Mexico Aging and Long-Term Services Department has allocated funds in the					
	21	amount of \$52,020 for July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017 to the Department of Senior					
	22	Affairs to meet the needs of the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program; and					
	23	WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque is desirous of applying for these funds					
	24	and contribute matching funds of \$158,634 City funds, which consists of					

\$27,362 for indirect costs and \$131,272 City cash match; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project is \$254,877.
