R-16-92 SPONSORED BY: Isaac Benton, by request 1 RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF THE ATTACHED GRANT 2 APPLICATION FOR AN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL GRANT WITH THE U.S. 3 4 **ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY** AND **PROVIDING** AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT IN 5 6 **FISCAL YEAR 2017.** WHEREAS, the Environmental Health Department has a performance 7 measure that it will protect and enhance air quality for current and future 8 generations and thereby protect public health, economic well-being and 9 aesthetic values for the community (Bernalillo County); and 10 WHEREAS, the operation of the Air Quality Programs of the Environmental 11 Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] - Deletion Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New Health Department provides the technical means of accomplishing these 12 13 goals; and WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque wishes to apply for federal funding for 14 which City matching funds of \$1,059,000 are required as the City's 15 contribution to the effort of the grant and which are available in the Transfer to 16 Operating Grants Fund Program in the General Fund (110); and 17 WHEREAS, Congress has provided the U.S. Environmental Protection 18 Agency with special funding to address special projects designed to enhance 19 20 public health by reducing air pollution. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 21 22 **ALBUQUERQUE:** Section 1. That the attached application for the Air Pollution Control 23 Program Grant in the amount of \$1,822,047 for the period of October 1, 2016 -24 September 30, 2017, is hereby approved and its submission and filing with the 25

appropriate official or office of the Environmental Protection Agency is in all respects approved.

Section 2. That in the event the grant is awarded, funds in the amount of \$1,822,047, consisting of \$763,047 from the Environmental Protection Agency and matching funds of \$1,059,000 from the Transfer to Operating Grants Fund Program in the General Fund (110) are hereby appropriated to the Environmental Health Department for the Air Pollution Control Program in the Operating Grants Fund (265) for Fiscal Year 2017.

Section 3. Of the \$763,047 from the Environmental Protection Agency, \$61,756 is for indirect costs and of the \$1,059,000 from the Transfer to Operating Grants Program in the General Fund (110), \$85,709 is for indirect costs.
